Competing Goals

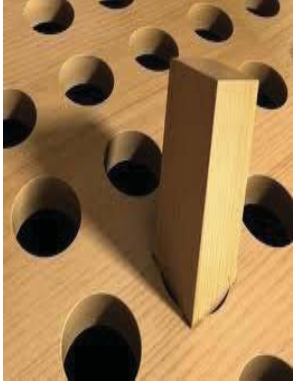


Manufacturer’s market access goals



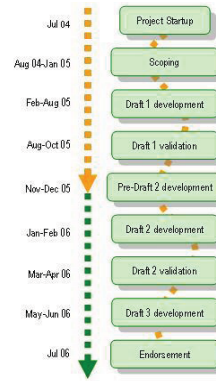
NICE’s CE threshold

Lack of Data



- Lack of robust data on key inputs and parameters
- Lack of key outcomes on key comparator data
- Lack of comparator data in populations of interest

Timelines



- Short timelines can lead to lesser quality
- Difficulty in exploring new methods, impetus to remain conservative
