Chapter's accomplishments with regard to Chapter meetings, workshops, or conferences	• Launched the annual meeting entitled "Ensuring Value for Money in Lebanese Healthcare", in February 2016 • LSPOR's first Educational Workshop "Importance of PharmacoEconomics and Data Registries in Lebanon", was held on November 25-26, 2016. This workshop is one of the components of LSPOR's educational program in the area of pharmacoeconomics (PE). The goal of the program is to provide key concepts in the discipline of PE to facilitate the translation of PE information to healthcare decision-makers engaged in developing policies and guidelines. The program offers both introductory and advanced topics taught by leading experts in the field and will be delivered in four modules and concomitant short workshops. It includes elements related to concepts of PE role in healthcare, PE models utilization, health technology assessment, budget impact analysis and pricing/ reimbursement policies. This two day educational program highlighted the need of data registry in Lebanon.
