LSPOR's second Educational Workshop "Budget Impact Analysis – introduction and application", was provided during the regular annual meeting held on February 24, 2017. This workshop was one of the components of LSPOR's educational program. • The goal of the program was to provide key concepts in Budget Impact Analysis (BIA) to healthcare members in the country. BIA is an essential part of a comprehensive economic assessment of a health care technology and is increasingly required, along with cost-effectiveness analysis (CEA), prior to formulary approval or reimbursement. • Our invited speaker from the USA, Mr. Russel Becker presented on Budget Impact Modeling guidelines and best practices, then participants were able to apply knowledge on a case using their laptops. • This Workshop covered the second module of the PE educational program and highlighted the need of BIA in Lebanon. There were around 60 attendees representing Pharma, academia, practitioners, and payers.
