Activities / Accomplishments	Summary
Scientific / Educational Activities	 Held 2 scientific workshops on: "Concept and Relevance of Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research in Developing Economies". The workshop was attended by 72 participants; most of them were not ISPOR members. "Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research in Health Care Policy Development'. Apart from keynote speeches, four short courses were introduced in an attempt to follow the format of ISPOR meetings. This effort will continue during the next workshops.
Policy-Related Activities	• A highly coordinated visit was made to several government agencies and regulators such as National Agency for Foods Drugs and Control (NAFDAC), National Health Insurance Scheme (NHIS), Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria (MDCN) etc. The aim of these visits was to sensitize and educate the executives of these institutions about ISPOR Nigeria Chapter and to invite them to participate in ISPOR Nigeria Chapter scientific activities.
Conferences and/or Chapter Meetings	• Four executive meetings were held in 2011: 3 meetings in Abuja and 1 in Asaba, Nigeria (December 2, 2011). 1 General Assembly Meeting was held at Bolton White Hotel on the 7 th of October, 2011; in Abuja, Nigeria, during a scientific workshop/conference. The December meeting held in Asaba focused on planning activities for 2012 as well as future development of ISPOR Nigeria Chapter.
Membership Development	• ISPOR Nigeria Chapter membership grew from 27 to 76 and continues to grow. A more coordinated approach to recruit new members will be implemented in 2012.
Other	• Several university students mostly from University of Nigeria and University of Benin attended ISPOR Nigeria activities in Abuja during 2011.
