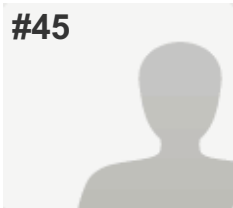

Health screening camp and patient counselling of elderly people was conducted in the month of July. We conducted 2 sessions on organ and skin donation for all the students in the month of September and October. Various aspects, methods and requirements for skin and organ donation were explained. We conducted health screening camp for girls in an orphanage in the month of December. Health issues observed in the screening camp were told to the care-taker and suitable measures to address them were advised to the screened individuals and their care-taker. Basics of health and hygiene were explained to the orphanage kids with the help of pictograms and posters.

Old-age home visit was conducted in July. Games, activities, health screening camp and patient counselling was done by the chapter members to approximately 100 elderly people.  
 Food donation drive in association with a local NGO was conducted in August. Around 5000 people were fed food free of cost.  
 Traffic control camp was organised in the festive season of October as traffic congestion is common problem experienced in the city during festivals.  
 Orphanage visit was conducted in the month of December where educational activities, games and health screening was conducted.  
 Donation boxes were set up in the university campus for a month to collect items which were donated to the orphanage kids in January 2017.
