## Fast Facts Sessions!

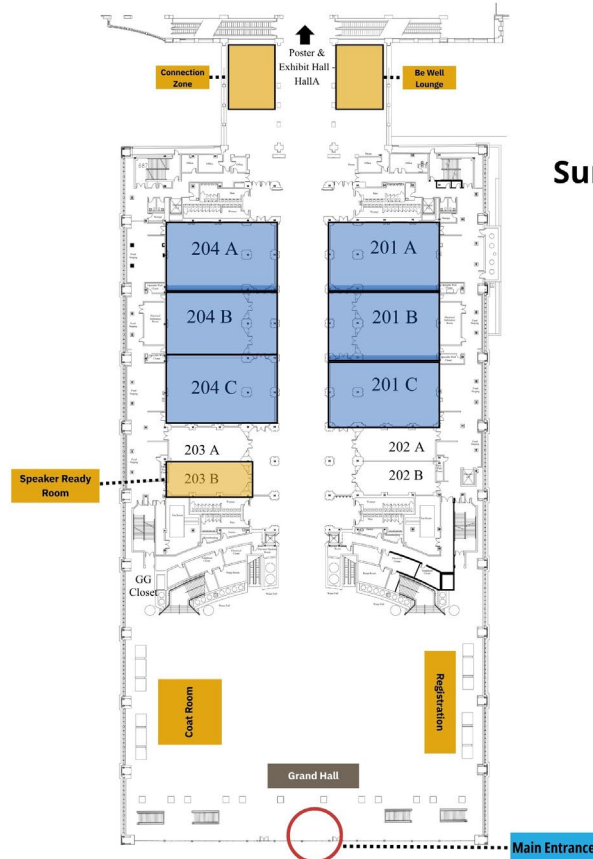
Have 30 minutes? Join in on a conversation and come away with new perspectives!
