Poster Presenter Responsibilities

Before You Arrive: Poster Presenter Action Items

Requirements:

- Register for ISPOR 2026 by **Friday, April 24**.
- Print and bring your poster to Philadelphia, PA, USA.
 - **Please do not ship your poster to the convention center.**
 - For your convenience, ISPOR has secured special rates with **Scientific Poster Printing**. Information on that later in the presentation.

Optional, Highly Recommended:

- **By or Before your Scheduled Session**, Upload the following to the ISPOR 2026 Task Portal so they appear in the conference app and ISPOR Presentations Database:
 - A digital version of your poster and
 - Supplemental materials (handouts, resources)
 - Files should be **pdf only** – we cannot support image, ppt, video, or audio file uploads

Note: all PDF presentations and handouts will be displayed in the mobile app (registrants only), ISPOR 2026 online program (public), and ISPOR Presentations Database (public) on May 17.

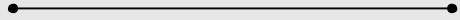
Onsite in Philadelphia : Poster Presenter Action Items

Requirements:

- Check-in to ISPOR Registration desk to obtain your **name badge** and **poster presenter ribbon**.
 - Poster presenters are required to wear your name badge for poster area access.
- Setup your poster at least **30 minutes prior to the start of your poster session**.
 - You will not be able to setup your poster before your assigned poster session time as we use the same boards across all sessions.
- Arrive at your poster at least **15 minutes prior to the start of your discussion time**.
- **Remove your poster at the end of your poster session**.
 - Any posters that are not removed are not the responsibility of ISPOR nor the Convention Center and will be discarded.

Optional, Highly Recommended:

- Explore other research, sessions, exhibits and all the great content available at ISPOR 2026!



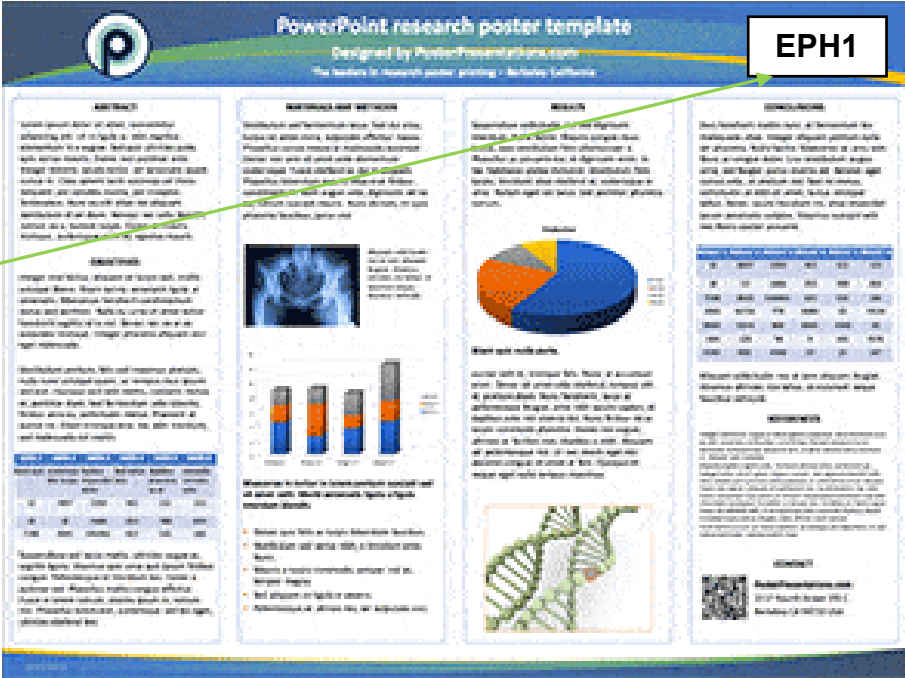
Poster Layout and Specifications

- Presenters must prepare a poster sized **36in x 56in or 42in x 56in.**
The **poster board** is **HORIZONTAL|LANDSCAPE** 4ft. (H) x 8ft. (L)
 - Materials must be **easily read at a distance of 3ft.**
 - As a rule of thumb, use a font size of 16 point to 32 point and double space.
- QR Codes are welcome as long as they are not commercial in nature.
 - ISPOR will not provide QR codes at your poster board
- Add your ISPOR-provided acceptance code to the top right-hand corner of your poster (example, EPH1)

NOTE: ISPOR will provide push pins.

Prior to the Conference, a poster board assignment (4-digit number) will be sent via email to poster presenters. ISPOR will print and display this number for authors.

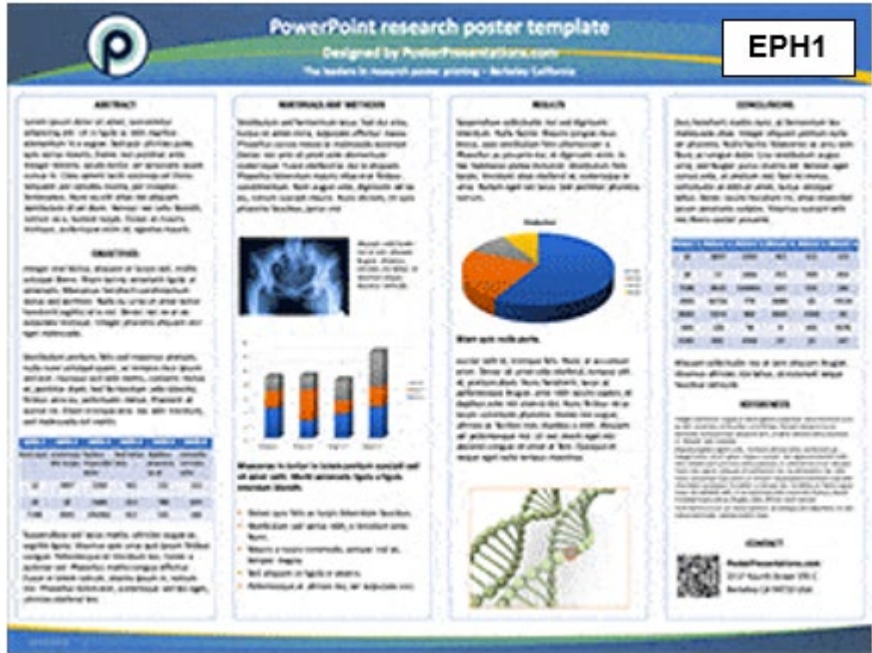

What's the Difference Between Poster Board Numbers and Acceptance Codes?

1000

Poster Board numbers are assigned and printed by ISPOR. This four-digit number indicates where you should hang your poster during your session. Presenters will receive their assigned poster board numbers approx. 1-2 weeks before the conference.



Acceptance codes are assigned by ISPOR in your acceptance notification emails. These are alpha-numeric codes. Presenters are required to print their acceptance code on the top right corner of their poster. This helps attendees find your poster in the ISPOR 2026 mobile app.



Printing & Shipping Your Poster

The presenter must organize any special shipping arrangements needed on their own. ISPOR will be unable to ship or store any material. **DO NOT SHIP YOUR POSTER TO THE CONVENTION CENTER IF YOU ARE NOT USING SCIENTIFIC POSTER PRINTING.** Please note: ISPOR is not responsible for any lost or misplaced posters shipped to the venue.

Scientific Poster Printing has created a specific link with rates for our ISPOR 2026 presenters.

With Scientific Poster Printing, you can either:

1. have your poster shipped directly to you (US addresses only), **or**
2. you can choose the “convention center” option where you will be able to pick up your poster onsite Sunday through Wednesday.

Poster sent to Printer Deadline: May 6, 2026. *After this date, a slight rush production fee will be required.*

Note: This is not a local printer, so there is not an option for pickup at the print shop. **For Questions**, please contact Scientific Poster Printing by emailing info@scientificposterprinting.com.

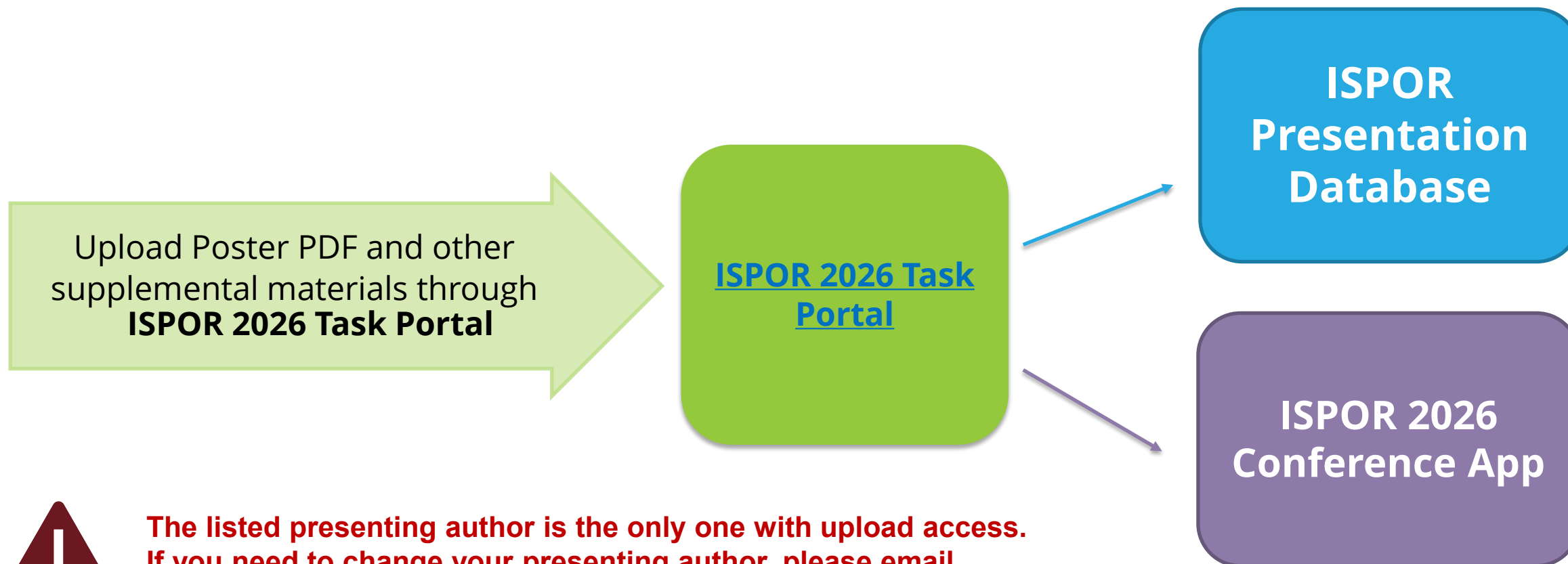

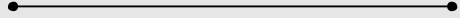

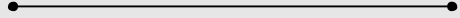
