

Campaigning Policies

- Candidates for President-elect and the ISPOR Board of Directors shall provide the Nominations Committee the following for posting on the ISPOR website: photo, biography, Vision Statement and contact information. ISPOR will provide links to the candidate's information in communications concerning the election.
- No Society funds, including Chapter funds, or in-kind contributions (office space, supplies, etc.)
 may be used to support or oppose the election of a candidate.
- Solicitation of campaign funds by a candidate or his/her supporters is not permitted.
- Candidates may not make campaign statements at any formal ISPOR meeting (including Chapter, SIG, Task Force etc.) without the other candidate for that office being invited to be present and accorded equal time to speak.
- It is permissible for candidates to inform their colleagues, associates or other members know that they are running for office.
- Members of the Board of Directors, Consortium, Network, Chapter, SIG, Task Force or other elected or appointed leaders may not endorse, support or oppose candidates, nor campaign on behalf of candidates for President-elect and the ISPOR Board of Directors.
- Any violation(s) should be reported to the ISPOR Nominations Committee for review and discussion.
