




INTRODUCTION


The Mighty is a patient-led social platform of ~3.5M members with predominantly chronic, rare, and mental-health conditions. Can we generate **RWE**, focusing on **disease burden** and **patient-defined measures of success** in rheumatoid arthritis?



What is the Top Burden? (Survey) Finding Effective Treatment Plan (67% top challenge)
What Drives The Burden? (SL) Switching (via social analysis)
Understanding Switch (SL) Switch burden influenced by patients making decisions (autonomy)
Switch Emotions Drive Burden (SL) 6X more likely to have positive switch experience if patient involved in decision; 14X more likely to have negative switch experience if not







CONCLUSIONS

ONLINE platforms are well suited to understand disease burden via rapid, in-depth insights gathered from patient-reported data.
