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

Transparency in HTA: Is There a Problem?





Data in Confidence

- Academic-in-confidence:
 - Clinical data not yet presented or published
 - Often focuses on secondary endpoints of interest to HTA (e.g., quality of life, resource use)
 - Often useful to understand subpopulation effects or near real-time assessment of primary endpoints (e.g., PFS)
- Commercial-in-confidence:
 - Pricing
 - Market conditions
 - Negotiated agreements with payers




Data in Confidence: The Good & Bad

- Accepting confidential data:
 - More comprehensive evidence base
 - Can explain nuances in summary data
 - Better precision in modeling
- Accepting confidential data:
 - Is resource-intensive (on all sides)
 - Can make comparisons problematic
 - May mask stakeholder-critical information
 - Not so great a "transparency" statement


