There are two separate locations to upload your ISPOR Europe 2022 presentation:

- 1.) **Orchestrate:** our online content system for the virtual platform and onsite Presentation Management.
- 2.) ISPOR Speaker Center: To advance our mission of promoting HEOR excellence to improve decision making for health globally, ISPOR requests that speakers also upload a PDF of their slide presentation to ISPOR Speaker Center. These PDF presentations will be displayed within the ISPOR Presentations Database and on the ISPOR website. Only presenters who have provided consent through Speaker Center will have their PDF presentation displayed.

UPLOADING YOUR FILES

Speakers can access ISPOR's virtual meeting platform and upload their presentation materials. Please see more detailed instructions below.

- Step 1: After your first system login, you will be prompted to create your own password (minimum length of 6 characters).
- Step 2: Locate the desired session you wish to upload to. Important: When naming your file, please keep the length <u>under 30 characters</u> and do not include special symbols \$ & + , / : ; = ? @ " <> # % { } | \^ ~ [] `as this will prevent your presentation from uploading through the submission website.
- Step 3: Click the "Upload" green button.
- Step 4: Browse out to your upload file/files target location, select the file(s) to upload, and click on "Open".

2 – INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPLOADING YOUR PRESENTATION TO ISPOR Speaker Center

- Step 5: If your upload is successful, you will receive a pop-up message indicating that the upload was successful, and your files will appear listed under the appropriate session/presentation.
- Step 6: Once the presentation is uploaded, please mark the ppt as the Startup file by clicking on the "1" button to the right of the file name.


Note: ISPOR requests that all PDF files are submitted with the following naming convention for easy identification within our database.

Step 1: Visit **Speaker Center** and log in using the email address used during the abstract submission process.

Step 2: Select **Presentation Schedule/PDF Upload** and click on the title of your session/presentation.



Step 4: Click **Choose File** and select the file from your computer. Click **Save** to upload your PDF presentation. Note: Only PDF files will be accepted.
