The event has been dedicated to the European Day of Antibiotic Awareness, the World Antibiotic Awareness Week, as well as to the 135th Continuous Pharmacy Class at the University of Zagreb. On December 11th 2017 HALMED organized a regulatory and pharmacovigilance conference on "The Complete Regulatory Approach - From Approval to Drug Administration".
