### **Greece Chapter Annual Report 2008**

(Hellenic Society of Pharmacoeconomics & Outcomes Research -HELSPOR)

- 1. HELSPOR publishes the quarterly scientific journal of "Pharmacoeconomia", which includes health economics studies conducted in Greece, accompanied by the news of the association (4 issues were published in 2008).
- 2. HELSPOR participated in the organization of the 11th European ISPOR Conference, Athens, 8-11 November 2008. Furthermore, it organized an Issue Panel under the title: "Is economic evaluation in the Greek health care context a feasible target or an intangible dream?" HELSPOR members presented several studies in workshops, podium and poster presentations.
- 3. HELSPOR members participated in the 4<sup>th</sup> Panhellenic Congress on Health Management, Economics and Policies, Athens, 3-6 December 2008, presenting studies and organizing round tables.
- 4. HELSPOR members participated in several national conferences, regarding pharmacoeconomics, health and pharmaceutical expenditure, the generic medicines market in Greece and the economics of mental health in Greece.
- 5. HELSPOR participated in a one-day workshop under the title "Careers in Health Economics in Greece", organized by the University of Thessaly (April 2008).
- 6. HELSPOR supervised the workshop on pharmacoeconomics, which was organized by Boehringer-Ingelheim (March 2008).
- 7. Members of the Greek HELSPOR participated during the ISPOR Conference in Athens at different events as speakers, poster presenters, or Members of Several Committees, (Co-Chairs, Congress Program Committee, Research Review Committee, Issue Panels
- 8. HELSPOR has also organized seminars on Pharmacoeconomics at the University of Athens School of Pharmacy.
- 9. Members of the Greek HELSPOR have published in the ISPOR Connections Journal analyzing the expenditures on pharmaceuticals at a European Level
- 10. Members of the Greek HELSPOR have also published in the journal of ISPOR "Value in Health" examining the psychometric properties of the EQ-5D instrument as well as the 15-D instrument on Health Related Quality of Life measurement.

## **Upcoming Activities for 2009**

- 1. HELSPOR will participate in the Balkan ISPOR Chapters conference organized by the ISPOR Serbia regional chapter in March 9-10<sup>th</sup> 2009 taking place in Belgrade.
- 2. HELSPOR will publish the quarterly scientific journal "Pharmacoeconomia", which includes Greek health economics studies, as well as the news of the Society.
- 3. HELSPOR will participate in the 5<sup>th</sup> Panhellenic Congress on Health Management, Economics and Policies, organizing a pharmacoeconomics seminar.
- 4. HELSPOR holds quarterly meetings of its members, in which scientific issues are discussed, as well as regulatory issues concerning the pharmaceutical sector in Greece.
- 5. HELSPOR members will organize seminars for the postgraduate students of the University of Thessaly, University of Peloponese, the National School of Public Administration and the National School of Public Health.
- 6. HELSPOR Members will continue to organize lectures at a under-graduate level on pharmacoeconomics and outcome research at the University of Athens School of Pharmacy
