We hosted Prof. Rosana Tarricone from Bocconi University in Milan, Italy.  On June 10, 2014, we have held the first annual conference on drug adherence, a joint conference with the Israel society for quality in healthcare, and the national council on diabetes. The successful event included clinical and policy leaders from all relevant stakeholders, and was concluded by a keynote by prof. Dan Arieli of Duke university. |
