Activities / Accomplishments	Summary
Scientific / Educational Activities	Twenty-one educational meetings were held throughout the year with a total of 250 in attendance. The training session titled, “Individuals or Companies Can Offer Pharmacoeconomics Studies” was given with 70 in attendance. Six other training sessions were held in the National Medical Congress with a total of 382 in attendance. An 8-month course was provided at the National Independent University of Mexico with 25 students participating. A course on diabetic economic issues was presented at the national Institute of Health with 15 in attendance. One meeting was held with the National Academy of medical Education titled, “Pharmacoeconomics in the Curriculum of Medical Students”. Six other meetings were held to continue work on the translation of the <i>ISPOR Book of Terms</i> .
