Introduction to Decision Analysis. Pharmacoeconomics - Health Economics and Health costs. Models of economic evaluation in health-cost disease (CMA, CBA, CEA and CUA, Decision Tree, Markov Models). Challenges to the interpretation and implementation of economic evaluations for decision makers. Also conducted a workshop on critical appraisal of pharmacoeconomic studies.
