Scientific / Educational Activities	<ul> <li>Health Technology Assessment (HTA) in the context of Pharmacoeconomics and Health Financing: An Appreciation Course. The AIM Zuellig Center along with the Chapter conducted a customized HTA appreciation course for the technical staff or members of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) last May 27-31, 2013. This course aimed to: 1) Provide an overview of the basic concepts and principles of HTA; 2) Promote an appreciation for the value of HTA in work relating to pharmacoeconomics and health financing; and 3) Translate HTA concepts into real-world applications through comprehensive discussion and analyses. Thirty four (34) representatives from PhilHealth's central and regional offices attended the said activity</li> <li>Health Technology Assessment (HTA) Across Asia: An HTA Symposium. The Chapter, in partnership with the AIM Zuellig Center conducted an HTA Symposium last October 3, 2013 at the Asian Institute of Management.
