- Russia HTA Chapter supports educational trainings on the topics related to health economics and outcomes research and conducts 5-10 such trainings every year - Russia HTA Chapter supported the largest International Conference of the 2015 in Russia dedicated to the topic of HTA development in country. Following the reports and presentations the participants of the Conference have issued the proposal: 1. For members of the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation and deputies of the State Duma of the Russian Federation: - to promote the amendments to Federal Law No.323 dated Nov. 21, 2011 "On Fundamental Healthcare Principles in the Russian Federation" and draft Federal Laws "On Biomedical Cellular Products" and "On Medical Products" in terms of health technology assessment implementation; 2. For the Government of the Russian Federation and the Ministry of Public Healthcare of the Russian Federation: - to accelerate the process of amendments to Government Decree No. 871 dated Aug. 28, 2014 "On Approval of Rules for Developing Drug Lists for Medical Application and Minimal Choice of Drugs Essential for Medical Care Supply"; - to accelerate the process of approval of essential legal regulations for the purpose of Federal Law No. 429-FZ dated 22.12.2014; - For the Ministry of Public Healthcare of the Russian Federation: - to develop a 'road map' for further introduction of the health technology assessment system into practice; - to develop health technology assessment methodology based on medical, socioeconomic and ethical approaches to data analysis and expert evaluation; - to develop a higher education program and extended training programs for the training, occupational retraining and advanced training of health technology assessment specialists
