ISPOR Russia HTA Chapter completed 4 Research & Development projects covering such topics as development of mechanisms of co-payments of medical and non-medical services and their economical burden in framework of the Program on State Guarantees to Deliver Free Medical Care to the Citizens of the Russian Federation, development of approaches for concretization of the Program on State Guarantees to Deliver Free Medical Care to the Citizens of the Russian Federation, enhancement of efficiency of healthcare system in regards to implementation of early HTA for diseases with high economic burden in the Russian Federation, scientific rationale for development of DRG system for specialized medical care in hospital and day hospital settings.
