NUMBER OF MEMBERS.

In 2014, the number of members MOOOFI reached 1684 people. Number of members of the Russian ISPOR branch is increasing - in 2007 - 436 members, in 2008 - 830, in 2009 - 1106, 2010 - 1197 people, 1327 people in 2011, 1381 people in 2012, 1561 people in 2013, 1570 members in 2014.
