Scientific / Educational Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chapter members have conducted 18 research projects on pharmaceutical pricing management, essential medicines policies and health insurance pharmaceutical management and reimbursement, funded by the National Development and Reform Committee, the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security, local bureau of health and China Medical Board. Research findings and policy recommendations have been forwarded to government decision-makers related and disseminated on workshops and journals.
Policy-Related Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chapter members actively joined the discussion of related pharmaceutical policies in China and became the members of many academic and government advisory committees, including the Association of Health Economics, Association of Health Insurance Research, Medical Association, and Pharmacoeconomics Branch of Pharmacy Association.
Conferences and/or Chapter Meetings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Shanghai Chapter Annual Meeting & Shanghai Pharmacoeconomics Forum titled ‘Revisiting Drug Formulary Adjustment from Multi-Perspectives’ was held on April 20 in Shanghai. There were totally 115 attendees. The topics covered review of China’s formulary adjustment, international experience on formulary adjustment, experience on formulary adjustment from Shanghai and Jiangsu province, impact of formulary adjustment on hospital, and the role of pharmacoeconomics in formulary adjustment. The speakers from WHO Western Pacific Region, Australia, France, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mongolia, Singapore, South Korea, and China mainland and Hong Kong, and other economies joined the discussion with over 170 participants.
