Chapter's accomplishments with regard to Chapter meetings, workshops, or conferences

One of the two organizers of the regional conference "The 6th Adriatic Congress of Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research" that was held in Bled form April 21-24, 2016 under the auspices of the Prime Minister of Slovenia Dr. Miro Cerar - 164 participants form 15 countries. As a part of the congress, we offered participants pre-congress training course on Managed Entry Agreements in the Adriatic region, which was rated (on a 1 to 5 scale) as follows: •the content of the training course – 4.44, •comprehensibility of the content – 4.47, •lecturers – 4.59, 4.12, 4.94, and 4.18, •organization – 4.81, •would recommend the training course to their colleagues – 100%.
