All research podium presentations are considered for an award. The top 100 research poster presentations, based on abstract review scores, are considered for a poster presentation award. These are identified with a rosette and will be judged during the meeting.

CONTINUING MEDICAL & CONTINUING PHARMACEUTICAL EDUCATION ACCREDITATION
